Follow Up Comments to March 5, 2014, LNG Engineering Conference Call**

Dear Ms. Bose:

On September 30, 2013, Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC, Sabine Pass Liquefaction Expansion, LLC and Sabine Pass LNG, L.P. (together, "Sabine Pass") filed an application for authorization to site, construct, and operate additional liquefied natural gas ("LNG") export facilities (the "Liquefaction Expansion Project") pursuant to Section 3(a) of the Natural Gas Act, as amended ("NGA"), 15 U.S.C. § 717b(a) (2012), and in accordance with Parts 153 and 380 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") Regulations, 18 C.F.R. Parts 153 and 380 (2013). Concurrently, Cheniere Creole Trail Pipeline, L.P. ("CCTPL") submitted an application requesting that the Commission issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing CCTPL to construct, own, and operate new interstate natural gas pipeline, compression, and related facilities in the State of Louisiana pursuant to Section 7(c) of the NGA, 15 U.S.C. § 717f(c), and in accordance with Parts 157 and 380 of the Commission's Regulations, 18 C.F.R. Parts 157 and 380.

On March 5, 2014, Sabine Pass participated in an LNG engineering conference call with Sabine Pass staff to clarify Sabine Pass' October 24, 2013, responses to questions 31, 34, 35, 43, 37, 38, 40, and 41 of the September 24, 2013, engineering information request. Sabine Pass is herein submitting clarifications to these responses.
