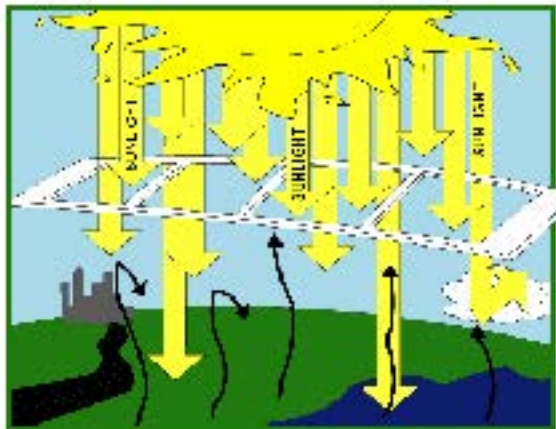

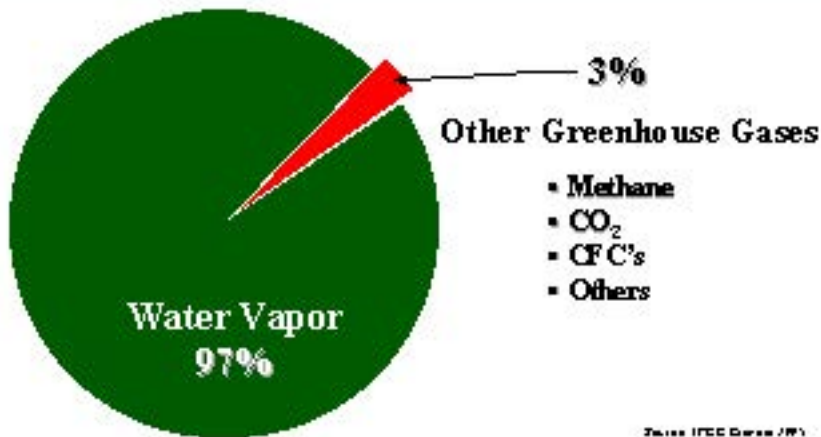

Greenhouse Gases

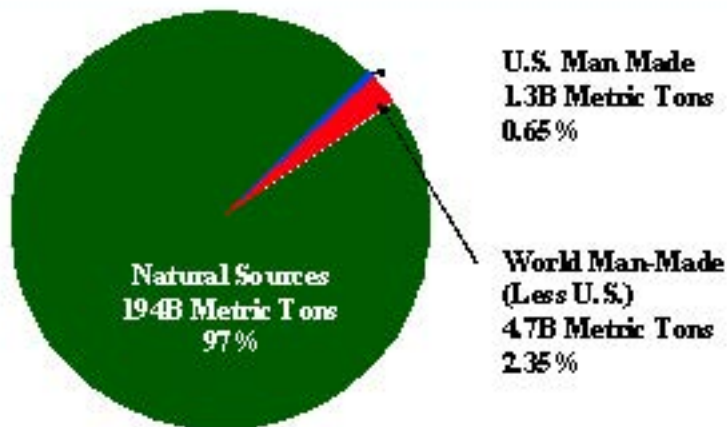


What is CO₂?

Scientific Consensus

“More than 2,600 scientists have signed a letter about climate disruptions ...”

Vice President Gore
July 28, 1997

- Only 10% with climate science disciplines
- only 1 climatologist
- included “scientists” trained in landscape architecture, linguistics, plastic surgery ...

Objective Opinion

Survey of 50 State Climatologists

- 58% disagree that global warming is a proven fact
- 9 out of 10 agreed that global temperature variations are cyclical and the result of natural causes

Seitz Petition

- Over 17,000 leading U.S. Scientists
- Premier scientists in the fields of
Climatology, Physics, Geophysics, &
Meteorology
- Overwhelming majority have advanced
degrees in Science

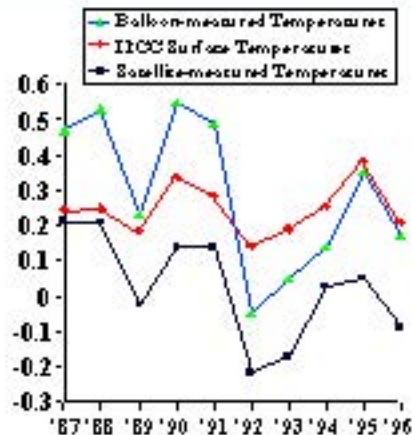
Emerging Consensus

“There is no convincing scientific evidence that human release of carbon dioxide, methane, or other greenhouse gases is causing, or will, in the foreseeable future, cause catastrophic heating of the Earth’s atmosphere and disruption of the Earth’s climate.”

Theory vs. Fact

Global Warming Theory

- based upon a computer model
- model's predictions have been proven unreliable
- predictions have been downgraded with new available information

Actual Weather Facts

- NASA satellite data show no evidence of warming over the last 18 years
- satellite record is confirmed accurate by weather balloon data
- 20th Century warming occurred mostly before 1940

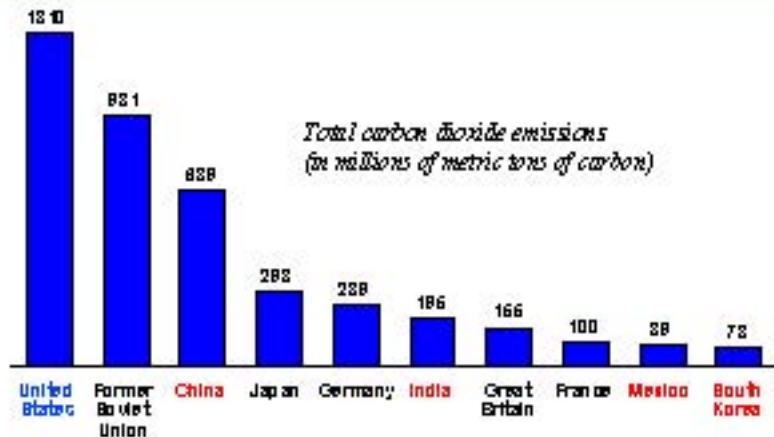

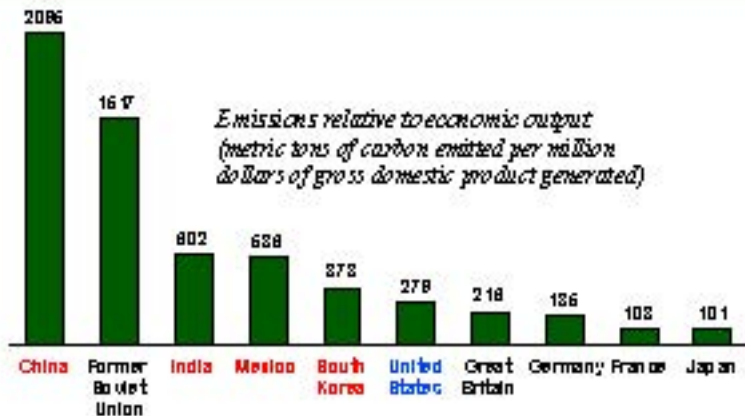
Kyoto's Flawed Perspective

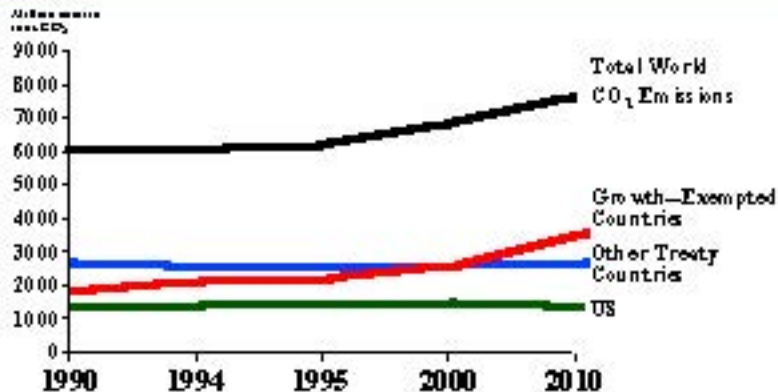
Emissions Reality

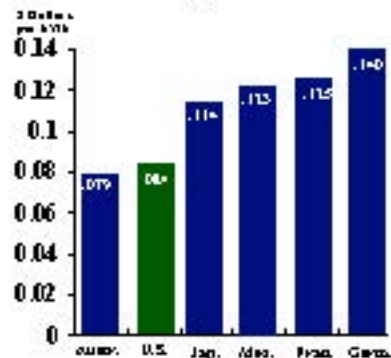

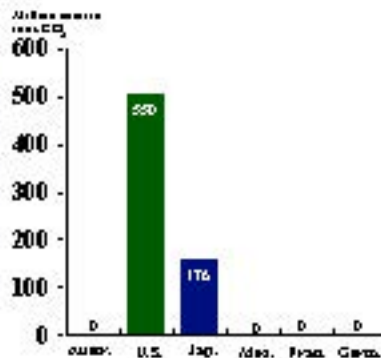
Energy Costs

Broken Promises—Shattered Dreams

U.S. Surrenders—Targets

White House Plan

- Reduce emissions to 1990-levels by 2008-2012

Kyoto Protocol

- Reduce emissions 7% below 1990-levels by the year 2012 (going from bad to worse)

Broken Promises—Shattered Dreams

U.S. Surrenders—Flexibility

White House Plan

- Flexible mechanisms for meeting targets
 - Joint Implementation
 - Emissions Trading

Kyoto Protocol

- Payments to U.N. for foreign aid projects
- Emissions trading limited to developed countries only

Broken Promises—Shattered Dreams

U.S. Surrenders—Global Participation

President Clinton

- “The U.S. will not assume binding obligation unless key developing nations meaningfully participate in this effort.”

Kyoto Protocol

- Only developed nations are bound to action (167 nations off the hook).

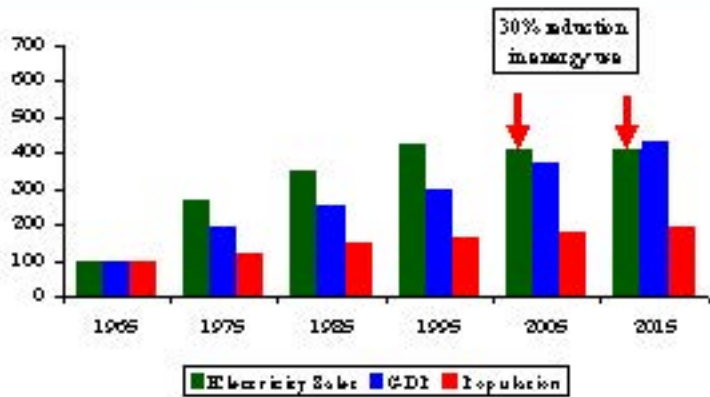
Who Pays the Cost?

Chemical

- 10% - 30% Industry Loss
- 100,000 Jobs at Risk
- From Trade Surplus To Trade Deficit

Aluminum

- U.S. Primary From Close By 1010
- 10,000 Jobs at Risk

Steel

- Production Cut By 30%
- 100,000 Jobs at Risk
- Production Moves To Non-Participating Countries

Pulp & Paper

- Ideal Energy Industry
- Serious Negative Employment/Output Impact
- Imports Displace U.S. Production

Petroleum Refining

- U.S. Refineries Become Non-Competitive
- Greater Impact In Northeast and Gulf Coast Regions

Cement

- Loss Of Up To 30% Of Output
- 3,000 - 5,000 Jobs Lost
- Greater Impact In Small Communities

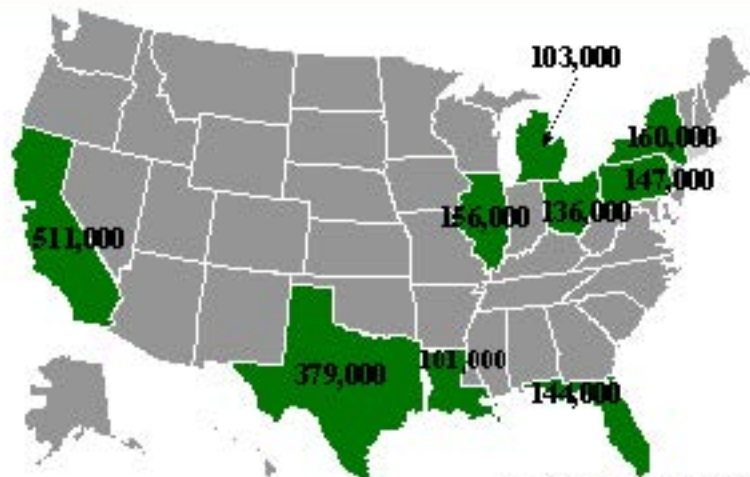
CONSAD's Findings

Kyoto Protocol will mean:

- Energy costs increase
- GDP declines \$317 billion in 2010
- High-skilled, high-wage jobs are lost
- Standard of living declines
