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Dear Lance,

The Department of Energy (DOE) recently approved a second application to export domestic liquefied natural gas (LNG) to countries that do not have free trade agreements (FTA) with the U.S. This long overdue decision should be followed by quick action to approve the remaining 19 permits, many of which have been languishing for months. A new report from ICF International shows [the tremendous economic benefits](#) the U.S. stands to gain from the right LNG export policies:

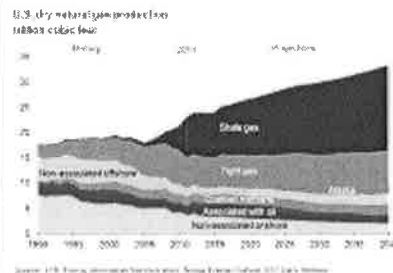
- 73,100 to 452,300 average net new jobs created between 2016 and 2035
- Net U.S. GDP gains of \$15.6 billion a year to \$73.6 billion by 2035
- Annual increases in revenue to federal, state and local governments of between \$6.4 billion to \$9.3 billion in the base scenario to \$27.9 billion to \$40.4 billion in the high-export scenario by 2035

The range in projections indicates the more we export, the greater the economic and revenue growth. In the two years DOE has been studying the issue, a number of additional studies confirm the multitude of export benefits and address opponents' concerns:

- Studies from the [Bipartisan Policy Center](#), [ICF International](#) and [Brookings Energy Security Initiative](#) determined that exports will not sharply drive up domestic natural gas prices
- A [2012 study conducted for DOE by NERA Economic Consulting](#) found LNG exports would generate net economic benefits "across all scenarios" -- with even "higher net economic benefits" the more we export
- [71 percent of Americans agree](#) that exporting natural gas will help create U.S. jobs while 66 percent agree exports are good for the U.S.

### Our Natural Gas Opportunity

The fact is [America has vast natural gas reserves](#) because of shale, developed with hydraulic fracturing and horizontal drilling. Here's how the U.S. Energy Information Administration charts production growth over the next few decades:

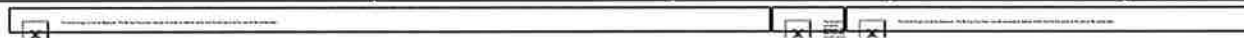
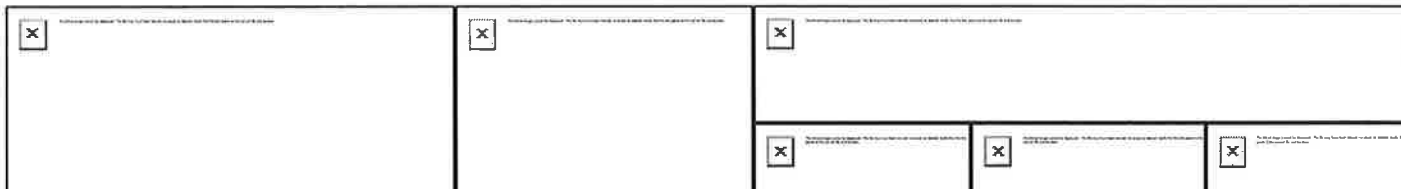

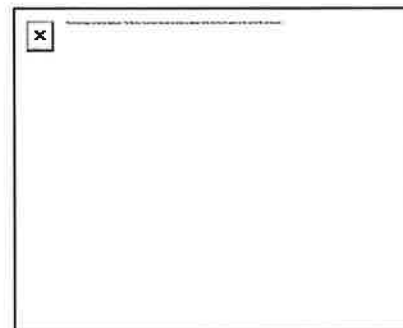

## **Time for Action on LNG Exports**

Dear Lance,

The crisis in Ukraine has focused renewed attention on the geopolitical significance of America's abundant natural gas resources. Several newspaper articles note our nation's opportunity to enhance stability and security in vulnerable regions by making U.S. energy exports more available to our allies. New legislative efforts to reduce self-imposed barriers to natural gas exports are welcome news to Eastern and Central European nations as well as allies in Asia like Japan that have long petitioned the United States for greater access to American energy in order to bring more diversity and reliability to their natural gas supply.

As a global energy superpower, the United States has unprecedented opportunities to positively alter the geopolitical landscape while generating significant economic benefits. Multiple studies show that allowing increased exports of liquefied natural gas (LNG) would create jobs, boost economic growth and increase government revenues across the nation. Studies from ICF International project a variety of economic benefits from LNG exports:

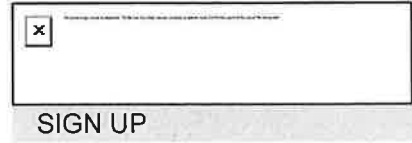
- Average net job growth ranging from 73,100 to 452,300 between 2016 and 2035
- Net effect on U.S. GDP between \$15.6 billion a year to \$73.6 billion by 2035
- Annual increases in revenue to federal, state and local governments of between \$6.4 billion to \$9.3 billion in the base scenario to \$27.9 billion to \$40.4 billion in the high-export scenario by 2035
- Economic gains as high as \$2.6 billion to \$5 billion in non-producing states like Ohio, California, New York and Illinois, due in part to demand for steel, cement, equipment and other goods used in natural gas

development

The federal government should be taking action to expand LNG exports and harness the opportunity to provide a much-needed boost to the economy and send a stabilizing signal to world energy markets. Instead, the Department of Energy has approved only six LNG export applications since 2011, leaving more than 20 in bureaucratic limbo. It's time to expedite the approval process and allow the United States to realize the full benefits of our status as an energy superpower. Otherwise, these multi-billion dollar investments could occur outside the United States and we could simply lose this valuable opportunity.

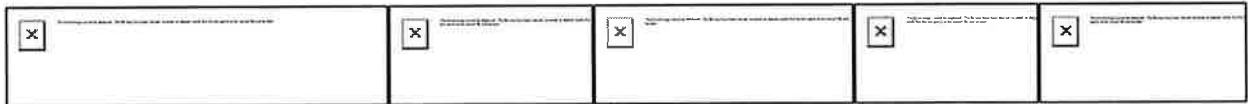

## **PASSAGE OF TIME**

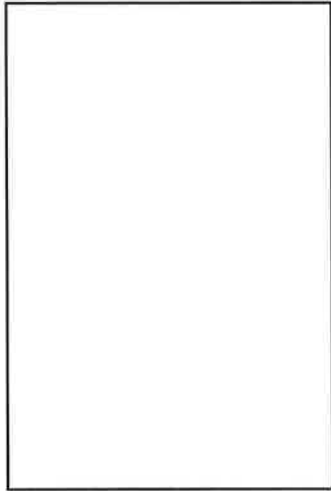

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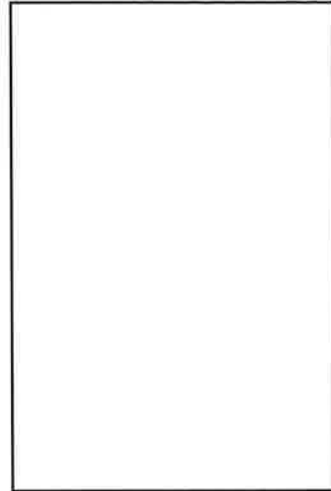
**Nic Walts Joins The Picard Group**

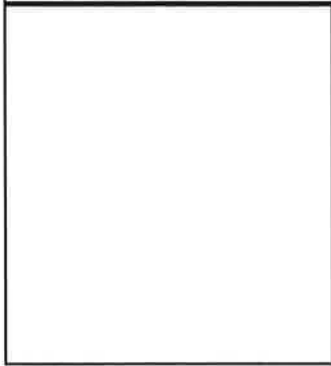
